On the December 2007 University Senate minutes there was an item pending your approval to to Change the Criteria for Temporary Graduate Faculty Membership from the Graduate Council:

Recommendation

To qualify for temporary membership on the Graduate Faculty, a faculty member must meet the following academic requirements:

- * Hold an appropriate degree and appropriate professional experience in the teaching field;
- * Present evidence for potential for effective teaching and high-quality scholarly and creative achievement;
- * Be involved in University and public service.

It removes " Hold the rank of assistant professor or above"

This is not the perfect solution to the problem of instructors holding grad faculty status, but it solves many of our problems. We have several ready for approval -- but we need your approval of this section of the senate minutes.
