MINUTES

Council of Academic Deans

April 7, 1975

The Council of Academic Deans met on Monday, April 7, 1975 at 1:15 p. m. in the Office of Academic Affairs. Present were Deans Cravens, Sandefur, Russell, Jenkins, Gray, Sutton, Chelf, Corts, Mounce, Hardin, and Davis. Dr. Chamberlin represented Dr. Hourigan at the meeting.

The deans discussed various aspects of the proposed 1976-77 Academic Calendar. Dr. Cravens appointed a subcommittee composed of Drs. Sandefur, Corts, Sutton, and Chelf to review the proposed calendar and bring recommendations back to the next deans' meeting.

The deans then commented at length on a possible revision in the present Extended Campus pay scale. Dr. Cravens asked Dr. Chelf to consider the suggestions made by the deans and to bring several alternative plans to the next deans' meeting.

Dr. Corts stated that the published Fall Semester Final Examination schedule included a typographical error. Faculty and students will be notified that evening classes will have their final examinations during the final examination period, and not the week before.

The deans discussed the listing of multiple section final examinations. The group agreed that it would be highly desirable to limit final exams to a one-week period.

The meeting adjourned at 3:15 p. m.
