PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to support the expansion of the current Parking Structure to accommodate 900 more spaces.

Resolution 03-XX-S
Disabled Student Parking

PURPOSE: For the Student Government Association of Western Kentucky University to recommend the creation of at least 2 extra handicapped parking spots in the area directly in front of Zacharias and Meredith halls as detailed in Appendix 1.

WHEREAS: Currently, there is an insufficient number of handicapped parking spaces to accommodate disabled students in campus' south-end dorms, and

WHEREAS: Disabled student access to the dorms is diminished due to the lack of overall parking, and

WHEREAS: There is a need for more handicapped parking spots particularly in the lot next to PFT, Meredith and Zacharias halls and adjacent to Normal Drive and University Boulevard, and

WHEREAS: This legislation is in the spirit of Resolution 02-05-F, ADA compliance (passed on October 22, 2002), in encouraging and assisting our University remain attentive to the needs of disabled students.

THEREFORE: Be it resolved that the Student Government Association do hereby recommend an increase of at least 2 handicapped parking spaces in the lot in front of Zacharias and Meredith halls. (**Please see appendix below.)
