COLLECTION NOTE

This collection contains oral history interviews conducted by film producer Dorian Walker for his 1995 docudrama *Beauty of the Southland*. Portions of the interviews were also used for a 2010 miniseries titled *All Aboard*. According to Walker's website, "*All Aboard: The Miniseries* brings to life the dramatic and fascinating stories of locating, moving, restoring, and placing on public display a locomotive." The collection consists of interviews with railroad employees—including engineers, telegraph operators, ticket agents, yard masters, and former railroad presidents—recorded on Betacam and Betacam SP videocassettes. Walker's work focuses on the history of the Louisville and Nashville Railroad, with a particular emphasis on how it affected local communities such as Bowling Green, Kentucky. Portions of some interviews were not donated.
