Williams was a Folk Studies professor at Western Kentucky University. She used these interviews when writing her book: *Staging Tradition: John Lair and Sarah Gertrude Knott* (Urbana, Ill.: University of Illinois Press, 2006) The nine interviews with friends and associates of Knott were conducted in 1995 and 1996 and funded through a grant from the Kentucky Oral History Commission. This collection includes only transcriptions; the original interviews did not come with this collection.
