This collection consists of recorded interviews conducted by WKU folklife students with members of the Bowling Green, Kentucky community about their memories of the Lost River Cave nightclub. The interviews were part of an event held on 7 March 1999 called "Echoes from the Past Lost River Cave Reunion," when about 110 community members gathered at WKU's South Campus to reminisce and learn more about Lost River Cave's history. The recordings were originally made on cassette tapes, but have been digitized and are stored in the Sound Archives.
