***ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY***

The Kentucky General Assembly authorized the creation of Barren County on 20 December 1798, and the county was officially organized on 10 May 1799. At its November, 1799 session, the county court established Glasgow as the county seat. By legislation approved on 31 January 1809, the Kentucky General Assembly authorized a board of five trustees, to be elected annually by the free white male inhabitants, to make bylaws governing the affairs of Glasgow.

By an act approved on 11 February 1878, the Kentucky General Assembly reorganized the government of the city of Glasgow, vesting legislative authority in a mayor and a city council consisting of six members.

***COLLECTION NOTE***

This collection consists of photocopies of the record books of the Board of Trustees of Glasgow, Kentucky, from 12 May 1810 through 10 January 1855 (Folders 2-4; a partial index is included at the end of Box 1, Folder 4), and photocopies of the minutes of the successor governing body, the Glasgow City Council, from 6 May 1878 through 24 March 1882 (Folders 5-6).
