

Resolution 79-18

Status:

Whereas, of April 1979 the Associated Student Government of Western Kentucky University relinquished all responsibilities for student activities and programming as approved by the WKU Board of Regents, and

Whereas, the University Center Board has been set up for the sole purpose of implementing campus activities, and

Whereas, the Associated Student Government can maintain close communications with the University Center Board without devoting a complete executive office position for that purpose, and

Whereas, in order for the Associated Student Government to expand and improve in new areas concerning student needs and feelings, and

Whereas, in order to adequately serve the student body in the area of student government it is deemed necessary that all executive officer's job responsibilities and duties should directly pertain to the operations of ASG and, furthermore, that no executive officer's constitutional duties commit them to major responsibilities in other major student organizations.

Therefore, let it be resolved that the Associated Student Government supports the proposed amendment to the ASG Constitution; Article II, Section 3, Subsection C.

Present Status:

C. The Activities and Program Vice-President shall:

1. Provide publicity for all Associated Student Government affairs, activities, and programs.
2. Be a voting member of Congress.
3. Shall be a representative of the student body in selection of concerts, lectures, and special programs through the University Center Board.
