***BIOGRAPHY***

Charles Fennell was a son of Joseph and his second wife, Mary (Wyles) Fennell. Joseph Fennell was born 15 August 1833 in Sandy Hook, New Jersey and settled in Cynthiana in 1857, working as a saddle maker. Later he developed what became known as a "horse boot," a leather covering, to keep standardbreds from cutting their lower legs with their own hooves. Joseph died 16 May 1919 and Charles died 3 January 1959. Both are buried in Battle Grove Cemetery, Cynthiana.

This collection contains correspondence of five Cynthiana attorneys. Below are brief biographies of each lawyer.

Chester Madison Jewett was born 13 February 1872 in Harrison County to John Benjamin Jewett and Lucinda F. (Daniel) Jewett. In addition to his professional concerns, his correspondence reveals his involvement in the Cynthiana Baptist Church and other religious activities. He served as Secretary-Treasurer of the Kentucky Hemp Brake Company and as a director of the Harrison Deposit Bank. He died 12 January 1941.

J. J. Osborne was a committed Democrat, a former circuit court judge, and the one attorney of the group who wrote most about politics in his letters. Osborne's boxes contain a large number of carbon copies of his business and personal letters. Because we have more of his own writings, his distinct personality is revealed more than the personalities of the other attorneys. He comments about his political rivals, state and local elections, and his role as a judge in a case resulting from an Eastern Kentucky feud. His correspondence with E.H.J. Walker about his Walker hounds, demonstrated his great love for fox hunting and fox hounds.

McCauley M. Swinford, often referred to as "M. C." or "Mack," was born 24 May 1857 in Pendleton County, Kentucky to John Patterson Swinford and Sarah D. (Terry) Swinford. A prominent citizen, Swinford was county attorney, a member of the state legislature, and president of the Harrison Deposit Bank, as well as mayor of Cynthiana. At one time he practiced law with both C.M. Jewett and J.J. Osborne and with his son by his first wife, Urban McCauley Swinford. His son by his second wife, Mac Swinford, served as a federal judge in Kentucky. Swinford died 13 September 1952 and is buried in Cynthiana's Battle Grove Cemetery.

William J. Osborne, brother of J. J. Osborne, was at one time the Robertson County attorney. He practiced law with his brother for a time and later became involved in the banking business. He served in the Kentucky legislature and much of his correspondence with his brother concerns state politics.

William Wilson VanDeren was born 15 March 1881 in Harrison County to John Van Deren and Martha Clay (Sanders) Van Deren. He served as both Harrison County judge and Cynthiana city attorney. His non-professional correspondence reveals his interest in the buying and selling of whiskey. He died 13 July 1966 and is buried in Battle Grove Cemetery, Cynthiana.

### ***COLLECTION NOTE***

The small town of Cynthiana, Harrison County, Kentucky during the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries is the unifying feature among the three distinct emphases of the Fennell Collection.

The first seven boxes of this collection deal with the Fennell family and the family's businesses. Box 1 includes the writings of attorney Charles Fennell, and various business and household receipts of Joseph Fennell. Box 2 contains account books of his successful Cynthiana Horse Boot Company and Boxes 3-6 contain account books of the clothing store he also established. Miscellaneous financial documents are found in Box 7, including an account book for the law firm Swinford & Evans, and for attorney Urban M. Swinford.

Box 8 contains correspondence and receipts related to the Kentucky Hemp Brake Company, also organized and located in Cynthiana. These letters show the interest of hemp growers all over the country in an implement that would effectively separate the fiber from the stalk. Letters from Lyster H. Dewey, botanist in charge of fiber plants, reveal that there was also interest from the U.S. Department of Agriculture. Attorney Chester M. Jewett was an official with this company.

Boxes 9-21 contain the correspondence of five Cynthiana lawyers: Chester Madison Jewett, J. J. Osborne, McCauley M. Swinford, William J. Osborne, and William Wilson VanDeren. Generally these attorneys were involved in similar types of legal actions. They represented clients in bankruptcy cases, real estate disputes, divorce proceedings, and debt collection. They settled estates, drew up deeds, and filed suits against individuals and companies. They occasionally worked together and occasionally opposed each other. All were Democrats and took an active interest in state and local politics.
