#### ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The LARTHS Literary Club was organized in 1925 with five charter members: Emma Lowe, Jewell Mueth, Lucille Robinson, Pauline Smith, and Nina Venable. It was the outgrowth of the Spinx Club, a study/social club they had enjoyed in high school. Herman Lowe named the club by using the first letter of each subject the club planned to study: Literature, Art, Religion, Travel, History and Science. Each member serves as a hostess and gives a program annually. The club meets semi-monthly from September until June and typically has a spring luncheon and a Christmas party.

#### **COLLECTION NOTE**

The records of the LARTHS Literary Club are divided into three series. Series I contains the organization's minutes, which are incomplete. Annual attendance sheets are generally found with the minutes of the September meeting each year. Minutes generally include information about the program, financial information, those in attendance, news about members, and the identity of the hostess and program presenter. Loose items placed with the minutes have been kept as the club secretary placed them.

Series II consists of the Club's yearbooks. This series too is incomplete. Second copies of yearbooks have been retained for posterity. The yearbooks include the membership list, dates and topics for programs, and the officers' names. A number of the program covers were designed by art teacher Lou Toomey. The 1938-1939 yearbook cover features an original drawing of the Warren County Courthouse by Arlene Rawlins.

Series III contains other administrative papers including copies of the constitution and bylaws, a few financial records, correspondence, historical information, news clippings, notes from programs, photographs, and a linoleum cut which was probably used for printing a special cover at one time. The photographs include snapshots of some early club members as well as the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary party held in 1985.
