ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Church of Christ was organized in Bowling Green about 1845. It came about as a result of the influence of the Restoration Movement led by Barton W. Stone, Thomas Campbell and Alexander Campbell. Around 1895 a division occurred within the church over the introduction of instrumental music in worship. Those who favored no instrumental music began to meet in private homes to worship.

Twelfth Street Church of Christ (now Lost River Church of Christ) was started when several individuals began to meet, as a result of the division, in a private home in January 1896. By June they were meeting in a public hall and later in the courthouse, where they met until 1899. The church built a meeting house in 1899. A lot was secured for the church from Clinton C. Potter for \$502.54, and a church building erected for a cost of \$3,331.43. The first meeting in the new building was held on 31 December 1899. Due to growth of the congregation, the church increased the building's size in 1924. In 1930 a group moved to the corner of Park and Thirteenth Streets, and in 1955 Lehman Avenue Church of Christ was established.

In 1956 Twelfth Street's building was remodeled, and in 1963 an educational wing was completed at a cost of \$52,000. Because of land constraints which deterred future growth, the church purchased property at 622 Dishman Lane in southern Bowling Green in order to build a new building. They began meeting in the new location, which featured a 600-seat auditorium, in April 2002.

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists chiefly of photocopies of the membership directories (Folders 7-21) of Twelfth Street Church of Christ. Folder 2 which contains membership information from 1950 to 1998 is restricted to staff use. Staff may confirm membership information from the folder; patrons may not view the contents of this folder or obtain copies from this folder. Also included in the collection are a few church newsletters and programs, deeds reflecting land

acquisition for the church, and items related to erecting an addition to the church building in 1963 (Folders 23 & 24). Folder 22 includes a large number of news clippings and items from denominational papers which reflect the church's history as well as other Churches of Christ in the region. This same folder contains some news clippings about former pastors. Folder 23 contains information about other Churches of Christ in Warren County, particularly Lehman Avenue Church of Christ and Park Street Church of Christ. Folder 26 contains historical information related to Potter Bible School and Potter Orphans Home in Bowling Green. Box 2 contains financial records of the church in the period from 1944 to 1966. The collection is almost entirely made up of photocopies from original documents.
