BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Nora Young was born on 20 September 1882 near Richardsville in Warren County, Kentucky. The oldest of 12 children, she was the daughter of Edward Green Young (1857-1948) and Sarah Jane (Runner) Young (1862-1952). Nora's father was a farmer who also served two terms in the Kentucky House of Representatives: see related collection MSS 309 – Young, Edward Green (finding aid at http://digitalcommons.wku.edu/dlsc_mss_fin_aid/1308/). Nora's siblings were Arch Young (1892-1985), Bertha (Young) Jones, Clive Young (1888-1979), Dewitt Carlton Young, Edwin Young, Harry D. Young (1897-1970), Heber Young (1886-1979), Homer Young (1895-1966), Walker Young (1908-1983), Walton Young, and Zula (Young) Duckett (1890-1984).

Nora graduated from the Southern Normal School in Bowling Green, Kentucky in 1905. The following year, she began teaching in the Arizona Territory, where she married Frank Wilbur Ferguson on 24 April 1907. In 1911, the couple moved to Frank's family farm in Saline County, Illinois. For the next forty years, Nora worked mostly as a teacher at various high schools in Illinois. Her career, however, was interrupted several times. She came to Bowling Green to secure medical care for her husband, but he died there on 22 October 1922. After his death, Nora attended Western Kentucky State Normal School and Teachers College (now WKU) for a year before returning to Illinois, where she earned a bachelor of education degree from Southern Illinois Normal University in 1929. She took further time off from teaching to care for her father-in-law until his death in 1931, and during the Depression she worked for the New Deal's Emergency Education Program. During World War II, Nora spent summers in Warren County with her aging parents, and taught high school in Wolf County, Kentucky. She retired from teaching in 1954 and took up permanent residence in Bowling Green.

Retirement gave Nora more time to pursue her interests in early American history, biography and genealogy. She became a member of numerous historical and genealogical societies, including the Daughters of the American Revolution, the National Huguenot Society, and the National Society Daughters of the Union. She helped to organize the Warren County Historical Society, and was county chair for the state's historical marker program. She wrote a history of the Green River Union Meeting House, an early nineteenth-century multi-denominational church established near her home town of Richardsville by descendants of

French Huguenots, and led efforts to repair and preserve the structure and its cemetery. Nora was also active in the American Association of University Women, the League of Women Voters, and the Richlandville Methodist Church.

In 1957, as the Warren County Courthouse was being vacated for a major interior renovation, Nora became concerned about the fate of thousands of neglected loose records, dating roughly from 1793 to 1880, that were stored in its basement. "A few of the older lawyers," she later claimed, "were going to have them thrown in the river" (Box 21, Folder 5). She obtained permission from the Warren Fiscal Court to take possession of the records and began to sort and classify them. Over the next several years, with the assistance of the Genealogical Society Library of the Mormon Church, she arranged to have these and other records microfilmed. As the custodian of the records, Nora received numerous requests, often via the Warren County Clerk, from genealogists interested in tracing their local roots, and she earned income by performing searches for a fee.

Nora (Young) Ferguson died on 30 November 1969 and is buried in Bowling Green's Fairview Cemetery.

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists of three parts:

1. **Boxes 1-10** contain the Warren County, Kentucky records that Mrs. Ferguson was permitted to remove from the county courthouse pending its renovation in 1957. The records relate principally to land (deeds, survey and processioning reports), wills and estates, roads and bridges, stray livestock, guardianships, surety bonds, county officers, lawsuits, and miscellaneous county business. A few scattered records relate to other counties. Note:

a. Records relating to Warren County marriages (bonds, consents, licenses) have been separated from this collection and incorporated into an existing collection: see MSS 230 – Warren County Marriage Records, at http://digitalcommons.wku.edu/dlsc_mss_fin_aid/584/

b. An alphabetical list of persons named in land entries (Box 1, Folders 2-8) is included on pp. 41-48 below;

c. An alphabetical list of persons named in land certificates (Box 1, Folders 9-12) is included on pp. 49-51 below;

d. An alphabetical list of persons who were subjects of wills (Box 5, Folders 1-10), estates (Box 6, Folders 1-20) or guardianship documents (Box 7, Folders 1-7) appears on pp. 52-61 below.

2. **Boxes 11-19** contain Mrs. Ferguson's collection of genealogy research and correspondence, relating either to her own ancestors or exchanged with third parties seeking family information. This material is in folders arranged alphabetically by family name, but many folders include data on related families. The contents of each folder vary, but may include correspondence, family data sheets, and research notes. The dating of the folders is approximate and generally represents the dates on any correspondence found therein. Box 19 contains mostly brief research notes from both primary and secondary sources, usually made on small slips of paper and arranged alphabetically by family name. Note that scattered correspondence of a genealogical nature also appears in Mrs. Ferguson's personal correspondence in Boxes 20 and 21.

3. **Boxes 20-24** contain personal papers of Mrs. Ferguson and her family, consisting primarily of correspondence between family members but also including some photographs and miscellaneous legal and household papers. Some original photographs have been transferred to the Special Collections Library.

Box 20 includes material related to Mrs. Ferguson's teaching career in Arizona, Illinois and Kentucky (Folders 3, 4), as well as letters to her from siblings (Folders 5, 7, 8) and other members of her large family (Folders 6, 11, 12). Also included is correspondence and reports from 1958-1963 relating to the microfilming of Warren County records, a project in which Mrs. Ferguson became deeply invested. For example, she writes of her suspicion of other interested parties such as WKU librarian Margie Helm, who, Mrs. Ferguson believed, objected to the Mormon Church's involvement in the project (Folder 9; see also Box 21, Folder 5).

Box 21 includes Mrs. Ferguson's general correspondence relating to personal, family, genealogical and community matters. Of interest is an 1899 letter from a young cousin, Maud M. Young, attending school in Kansas, and 1940s correspondence regarding Mrs. Ferguson's interest in organizing a teachers union in Bowling Green (Folder 1). Also of interest is a 1963 letter from "Lorena" in Denton, Texas, who was nearby when President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in Dallas; she describes the aftermath and comments on local race relations (Folder 4). Letters from a niece teaching in Illinois also comment on the increasing integration of the schools at this time (Folder 6). Other activities of Mrs. Ferguson covered by this correspondence include her attempts during World War II to find teaching, civil service or other work in support of the war effort (Folders 1, 2); her support of Kentucky Democratic political candidates (Folder 4, 6); her promotion of local heritage tourism and the preservation of the Green River Union Meeting House (Folders 4, 6); and her involvement in the National Huguenot Society and the Warren County Historical Society (Folder 6).

Box 22 contains miscellaneous personal papers of Mrs. Ferguson and her family. Included are documents relating to the estates of both her husband and father-in-law, and to her inheritance of the latter's properties in Saline County, Illinois (Folders 1, 2). Also included is correspondence relating to Mrs. Ferguson's efforts to be reimbursed out of her father-in-law's Civil War pension for her expenses as caregiver (Folder 1). Miscellaneous material in this box includes telegrams relating to Miss Kentucky's 1963 appearance at the Miss America Pageant (Folder 6); Edward T. Breathitt campaign material (Folder 7); an early prohibition essay and song (Folder 8); family school certificates and diplomas (Folder 9); and photographs, some of which have been transferred to the Kentucky Library (Folder 10).

Box 23 contains materials relating to Mrs. Ferguson's work with the Warren County Historical Society (Folders 1-5), the preservation of the Green River Union Meeting House and cemetery (Folders 6-9), and the promotion of local history through the state highway marker program (Folder 4). Mrs. Ferguson's history of the Green River Union Meeting House is included (Box 23, Folder 6). Narratives concerning Illinois history (Folder 10), and some original early Illinois tax receipts (Folder 11) are also included.

Box 24 contains mostly correspondence and papers of Nora's parents, Edward G. Young and Sarah Jane (Runner) Young. The Civil War discharge certificate of Sarah's father, William Runner, is included (Folder 2). Papers of Edward G. Young include deeds and other documents relating to the farms he owned near Richdsville and Rich Pond, Kentucky (Folder 4) and a teacher's register dating from his service as a school trustee (Folder 6). Edward also writes several letters from Frankfort during his service in the Kentucky General Assembly (Folder 9). Most of the correspondence is addressed to Edward G. and Sarah Jane Young by various

family members (Folder 7) and by their children: Homer Young, who writes primarily of his pastoral activities as a Methodist minister in Illinois (Folder 10); Walton Young (Folder 11); Dewitt Young, written over the course of his second and third marriages (Folder 13); and Walker Young, written during his World War II Army service in Ohio, Mississippi, Texas and Nebraska (Folders 14-15). Walker's letters do not contain a great deal of descriptive content, but they do reflect his state of mind as he struggled with boredom and illness, and with his intensifying desire to return home after four years' service. A childhood letter by Zula Young describes an outbreak of measles among family members, and her siblings' schooling (Folder 5). Also included in this box are Mrs. Ferguson's notes providing data and anecdotes about her family and her ancestors in the Young, Taylor, Hudnall, Chastain and Runner families (Folder 3).
