CLINIC REPORT

From July, 1936 to July, 1937

The following is a summary of the work accomplished from June, 1936 to June, 1937.

Every child and student must take some specific health work some where, some way in our Training School and first two years in the College Department. Several offerings are made in the line of Health Courses, Home Economics, General Science and Physical Education. Educational programs have been put on from time to time in the form of lectures, posters and nutritional exhibits and individual advice given to the parents and students at the Clinic.

A health record is kept for each student at the Clinic.

Physical inspection given all students in the College, Training School and Rural School first of every semester.

Class room inspection given all children in the Training School from kindergarten through the sixth grade every day.

A follow-up letter to parents and college students informing them of the defects found, advice given, also encouraging them to have all defects corrected.
