Dear Mr. Thompson:

For your information our school has taken over the complete administrative responsibilities of the Practical Nursing School at Glasgow, Kentucky, as of February 1, 1957.

The board of directors that was set up to begin with is being dissolved, some members of the board will become an advisory committee with the responsibility of helping me administrator a sound and complete program in practical nursing education.

The program is a permanent part of our school, the instructors (registered nurses) are on exactly the same status as the instructors here.

I have submitted the budget for the operation of the school to Mr. Billy Smith. Some \$10,000.00, in addition to our regular budget, will be required this fiscal year.

Any expenditures that come through your business office will be reimbursed usually within forty-eight hours after the sworn statements reach Mr. Fred Martin's desk.
