**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Alexander Gordon Wilson (known as Gordon Wilson or Gordon Wilson, Sr.) was born on 14 October 1888 to Dr. Marquis Pillow Wilson (1847-1915) and Malinda Jane Robertson (1848-1929) in New Concord (Calloway County), Kentucky. Wilson attended New Concord Rural School (1895-1905) and Clinton College (1907), and taught in the rural schools of Hickman County. He entered the Western Kentucky State Normal School, now Western Kentucky University (WKU), Bowling Green, Kentucky, in January 1908 and received a life teaching certificate in June 1913. On 9 September 1913, Wilson married Avis Hines (1892-1983) and they departed for Indiana University in Bloomington, where Wilson earned a bachelor's degree in 1915. He subsequently earned a master's degree (1924) and a Ph.D. (1930) from Indiana.

Wilson began teaching at the Western Kentucky State Normal School as a student in 1912, then became an instructor in 1915. After serving as acting head of the school's English department, he was formally appointed head in 1928 and held the position until his retirement on 7 August 1959. In 1968, the former library building on the campus of Western Kentucky University was named Gordon Wilson Hall in his honor.

In addition to his teaching, Wilson was known for his lifelong studies of folklore and folkways. In 1935, he began publishing a weekly column, "Tidbits of Kentucky Folklore." The column appeared in local newspapers for the next 35 years and became the basis for two books, *Passing Institutions* (1943) and *Fidelity Folks* (1946). Wilson joined the Kentucky Folklore Society in 1922 and served as its president and publications editor. After his retirement, Wilson conducted interviews of residents and collected extensive data on the folkways—speech, plant, animal and weather lore, superstitions, folk beliefs and remedies, etc.—of the Mammoth Cave region of south central Kentucky. He published numerous articles on his studies as well as a booklet, *Folkways of the Mammoth Cave Region* (1962, 1967). He shared his linguistic research with editor Frederic G. Cassidy of the University of Wisconsin for Cassidy's *Dictionary of American Regional English*.

Wilson was also an accomplished amateur ornithologist. Drawn first to botany, he began to observe birds about 1909, and while studying at Indiana he began to keep records of his nature walks and sightings. When he returned to Bowling Green, he contracted "ornithological fever" and published his first major article on birds in *The Auk* in 1921. For decades afterward,

Wilson conducted extensive fieldwork on the birds of south central Kentucky, including Mammoth Cave National Park. Among his numerous publications were *Birds of Bowling Green, Kentucky* (1922), *Birds of South-Central Kentucky* (1962), a pamphlet, *Birds of the Mammoth Cave National Park* (1946, 1953), which became a popular park souvenir, and *Birds and Their Habitats in Mammoth Cave National Park* (1968). Wilson was one of the founders of the Kentucky Ornithological Society in 1923 and edited its publication, *The Kentucky Warbler*. He wrote his Ph.D. dissertation on Scottish-born ornithologist Alexander Wilson (1766-1813).

After ten busy retirement years of research, writing and lecturing, Gordon Wilson died on 12 April 1970. He and his wife were the parents of two children, Winifred (b. 1918), who married Harold E. Hughes in 1939, and Charles Gordon Wilson (1925-2007), who was known as Gordon Wilson, Jr.

### **COLLECTION NOTE**

This collection consists of Gordon Wilson's correspondence, published and unpublished writing, and research data on ornithology, regional folklore and speech.

Box 1 contains mostly biographical and bibliographical data on Wilson as well as some of his speeches and writings. Folder 1 contains the collection inventory and correspondence regarding Wilson's donation of the collection, including the lifting of restrictions on access to his "Diary to Kelly" (Boxes 5-6). Folder 2 contains biographical articles and clippings on Wilson, and Folder 3 contains correspondence and data relating to Wilson family genealogy. Folder 4 contains various lists of Wilson's publications, addresses, trips and other professional activities. Folder 5 contains various certificates, diplomas and cards. Speeches and addresses include those given by Wilson at numerous schools and colleges in Kentucky (Folders 6-7); to WKU's Leiper English Club (Folder 8); and at the presentation of the English department's annual Gordon Wilson Award (Folder 9). Miscellaneous speeches and writings are in Folders 10-12.

Boxes 2-4 contain Wilson's diaries, kept from 1905 to 1919. Much of the diaries are taken up with effusive observations of the weather and of nature, but Wilson records some of his activities as a student, including his participation in the move of the Western Kentucky State Normal School from downtown Bowling Green to its new campus on "the Hill" in February 1911 (Box 3, Folder 5) and a school excursion to Mammoth Cave on 14 May 1909 (Box 3, Folders 1, 2).

Boxes 5-6 contain Wilson's "Diary to Kelly." Begun upon his retirement from Western Kentucky University in 1959, the diaries take the form of letters "about Western and its problems," intended solely for the eyes of WKU President Kelly Thompson. Although the entries may be prompted by a particular event, they contain a great deal of autobiographical information, reminiscences, and musings of Wilson, as well as candid impressions of faculty, students and the state of the university in general.

Box 7 contains drafts of an autobiographical manuscript by Wilson, arranged roughly by chapters corresponding to particular aspects of his life. A chronology of Wilson's life appears in Folder 3, pp. 10-13, and a brief chronology of his ornithological studies is in Folder 8, pp. 12-13.

Box 8 contains Wilson's general correspondence, almost all of it created at or after his retirement in 1959. Included in Folder 1 is correspondence with publishers regarding *Passing Institutions* and *Fidelity Folks* and a small amount of genealogical correspondence, but most of this folder contains exchanges with friends and colleagues upon Wilson's retirement. Folder 2

includes many letters of appreciation from students, friends and colleagues to whom Wilson sent copies of his publications; also included is a summary of sales of *Folkways of the Mammoth Cave Region* and some genealogical correspondence. Folder 3 includes correspondence relating primarily to Wilson's research; he details the progress of his work in the Mammoth Cave region and corresponds with editors of scholarly journals about publishing articles. Folder 4 also relates primarily to his Mammoth Cave region research and publications; included is a letter from Jesse Stuart thanking him for a complimentary review. Folder 5 includes correspondence relating to Wilson's publications, including new editions of *Folkways of the Mammoth Cave Region* and *Birds of the Mammoth Cave National Park*, and updates on his post-retirement activities. Folder 6 includes further correspondence with colleagues and editors relating to Wilson's activities, research and publications, as well as his sale of the rights to *Folkways of the Mammoth Cave Region* to National Park Concessions, Inc., his compilation of 1,800 "Tidbits of Kentucky Folklore" columns for deposit in WKU's Special Collections Library, and his gift of his folklore and ornithology research materials to WKU. Folder 7 includes further correspondence with colleagues and other professionals regarding Wilson's research and publications and the compilation and indexing of his "Tidbits" columns, as well as letters from former students and letters of thanks from recipients of recent publications. In letters to familiar correspondents, Wilson continues to provide detailed updates of his activities, and in May and July 1969 he describes the severe hailstorm that occurred in Bowling Green in April of that year. Folder 8 includes further correspondence relating to Wilson's research and publications, including an update on the *Dictionary of American Regional English* to which he had contributed. Folder 9 contains a letter to Wilson's widow from Jesse Stuart regarding their friendship.

Box 9 contains material relating to Wilson's studies at Indiana University, and to his doctoral thesis on ornithologist Alexander Wilson. Folder 1 contains miscellaneous materials relating to Wilson's teachers at Indiana and the defense of his dissertation. Folder 2 contains the abstract of Wilson's dissertation and miscellaneous clippings and information on Alexander Wilson. Folders 3-4 contain the typescript of Wilson's dissertation, and Folders 5 and 6 contain typescripted compilations of Alexander Wilson's writings.

Box 10 contains materials relating to Wilson's ornithological studies in south central Kentucky. Included (Folders 1-3) are research data, notes, and published and unpublished materials relating to *Birds of South-Central Kentucky* and *Birds of Bowling Green, Kentucky*; also included (Folders 4-7) are data and publications relating to Wilson's studies of the transient bird habitats on the C. U. McElroy and Chaney farms near Woodburn, Kentucky (the "Woodburn Lakes"). Folder 2 includes addresses on his studies delivered at various clubs and ornithological society meetings, and a review of the first forty years of the Kentucky Ornithological Society.

Box 11 contains collected articles and addresses by Wilson on ornithology, including the subject of his dissertation, Alexander Wilson (Folders 1-3). Also included (Folder 4) are miscellaneous materials relating to the Kentucky Ornithological Society, including its first (1924) annual meeting minutes and fortieth anniversary (1963) materials. Other miscellaneous ornithological notes, data and checklists are in Folder 5.

Box 12 contains research data and notes relating to Wilson's studies of the ornithology and folkways of the Mammoth Cave region. Notes outlining the scope and objective of his studies are in Folder 1. Collected data, notes and studies relating to ornithology are in Folders 2-4. Wilson's data and writings on the region's speech characteristics, local place names and

surnames, sayings, folklore and folkways are in Folders 5-10. Of interest (Folder 6) is a collection of obscenities gathered mostly from employees of Mammoth Cave National Park. More general notes and writings on the study of regional speech, including testing materials, are in Folders 11-13.

Box 13 contains Wilson's miscellaneous notes, writing and speeches on ornithology and folklore, and photographs. Included are articles on Calloway County ornithology and animal lore (Folder 1); artwork for *Fidelity Folks* by WKU art faculty member Ruth Hines Temple (Folder 2); collected articles, speeches and radio broadcasts on folklore (Folder 3); collected columns "Birds and the Out-of Doors" and "A Number of Things" that ran in Bowling Green newspapers in the 1920s (Folder 4); an incomplete collection (both published and in typescript) of "Tidbits of Kentucky Folklore" columns, and notes about the indexing project (Folders 5-7); and miscellaneous notes on folklore and folk beliefs (Folder 8). Copies of photographs, both of Wilson and of locations related to his studies, are in Folders 9-11. The original photographs have been transferred to the Special Collections Library.

Boxes 14-16 contain reel-to-reel audiotapes, mostly of Gordon Wilson's interviews of Mammoth Cave area residents in connection with his speech and folklore studies. Wilson's tape indexes, and an alphabetical list of interviewees, are in Box 14, Folder 1. A small number of these recordings have been digitized and saved onto compact disc. Also included are some recordings of speeches by Wilson.

Boxes 17-21 contain Wilson's ornithological research data. A summary of the materials is in Box 17, Folder 1. Boxes 17-20 contain thousands of data cards from 1918-1970 used by Wilson and others to record bird sightings. The cards are grouped by year and record the date, time span, locality, observer, and species of birds observed. Many record sightings at Mammoth Cave National Park, and others record sightings in Bowling Green and Warren County. The cards have not been individually counted, and consequently are not included in the item count for this collection. Box 21 contains data cards representing mostly annual compilations of bird sightings in Bowling Green, Warren County and Mammoth Cave National Park. These cards have not been individually counted, and are not included in the item count for the collection.

Boxes 22-42 contain Wilson's research data on the folkways of the Mammoth Cave region. Most of the material consists of word usages, definitions and other aspects of speech, as well as folk beliefs, remedies and sayings. The data is recorded on 3X5-inch cards or on slips of paper. The cards have not been individually counted, and consequently are not included in the item count for this collection.
