BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Thomas Wilson Nida was born on 22 June 1949 to Dean Wilson and Minnie M. (Peting) Nida in Athens, Ohio. He graduated from Pershing High School in Springfield, Missouri, and later served in the U.S. Navy. After his service, Tom worked for the U.S. Post Office and retired after twenty years. In his retirement, Nida was an avid canoer and spent much of his time exploring the many rivers and streams in Kentucky.

COLLECTION NOTE

This small collection consists primarily of journals in which Thomas W. Nida's records information about his many canoe trips on the rivers and streams of Kentucky, chiefly the south central region. Journal entries typically include the date, temperature, place of launch and length of trip. He also records information about traveling companions, waterway conditions, as well as flora and fauna spotted. The collection also includes 26 photographs that document his canoe treks.

Metal spirals were removed from several notebooks. Photographs were placed in protective sleeves. Loose materials found in the journals were placed in Folder 4.
