Correspondence of Charles Ewing Nourse, Bardstown, Kentucky, and his wife Mary "Mollie" (Brown) Nourse. Three letters of Charles, serving in the 4th Kentucky Infantry during the Mexican War, describe military life, illness, Mexican cities, and encounters with the enemy. Mary's father writes from Cadiz, Kentucky, of his work as a circuit judge, and an 1850 letter wishes Charles and Mary well on their marriage. Includes Mary's letter to Charles with family news, and two verses, both probably by Charles; one appears to refer to a romance of Mary's sister Lucy. Also includes Charles's youthful description of a squirrel hunt.
