At a committee meeting in the Tea Room of the J. Whit Potter Hall today, August 7, 1934, the following were present: Mr. J. R. Whitmer, chairman, Dr. A. M. Stickles, Dr. M. C. Ford, Miss Florence Schneider, Mrs. M. A. Leiper, Miss Mattie McLean, Mr. W. J. Craig, Mr. W. L. Matthews, and Mr. L. T. Smith. Among the things discussed was the plan to bring before the Board of Regents officially the matter of erecting the statue of President H. H. Cherry and the designation of the proper location.

It was the consensus of opinion that steps should be taken to place ^{the matter} before a larger group during the Homecoming, 1934, as November 16 will mark the 70th anniversary of President Cherry; and with this in view the chairman was asked to appoint a committee to consider plans and to present them for the approval of this group at the next meeting. This motion was made by Mr. L. T. Smith, seconded by Mr. W. J. Craig and unanimously passed.

Dr. M. C. Ford moved that the chairman be authorized to appoint a committee who should re-consult, see the statue, and accept it according to the sculptor, Mr. Lorado Taft's, wishes, the committee to make the trip to Chicago on the expense of the organization. It was the opinion of all of those present that a member of the Board of Regents should be one of this number.
