Minutes

A group of the members of the faculty who were especially interested in launching a campaign leading to the carving and erection of a statue of President Cherry, met in the dining room of the J. Whit Potter Hall for the purpose of discussing "ways and means", at noon of October 10, 1933.

During the discussion a motion was made by Dr. Ford to the effect that a committee ~~be appointed~~ composed of the heads of the different departments be appointed to bring before the members of his staff the proposed undertaking and to give each one of them the privilege of making the same contribution that each individual present today volunteered to make. The motion was given a second and unanimously passed.

Following the passage of this motion it was decided that it would be well to have a subcommittee to first meet and formulate a plan or ^{that will} to indicate just the method and manner of approach, the definite amount of subscription to be received, etc., etc.
