Unsigned letter, 31 January 1862, thought to be from William Frazier of the 33<sup>rd</sup> Indiana Infantry, to a female friend. Writing from Camp Henderson, Kentucky, he sympathizes with her inability to take time from her studies to correspond. He also refers to the weather and his duties as a cook, and mourns the recent deaths of two members of his company.
