SC 3255 NEWCOMB, Horatio Victor, 1844-1911 1878

Letter, 15 March 1878, of H. Victor Newcomb, Vice President of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad, in reply to Irvine Wells(?). He recollects that in 1863 his father paid about \$3,000 in gold for “the Turner painting” now in Wells’s possession, and invites Wells to visit him and his wife at his “old homestead.” Includes Newcomb’s obituary from the November 4, 1911 *New York Times* and an August 31, 1901 *New York Times* article about his release from a sanitarium in Central Valley, New York, where he had been confined for a mental illness.
