Letters, 28 March and 27 April 1919, of Arthur Milem to his future wife Bendola White in Covington, Kentucky. Writing from Verdun, France, where he is serving with the American Expeditionary Force, he reports on the weather, letters received from family and friends, and his uneventful military life. Noting that his is now the oldest company left at Verdun, he expresses hope that orders will arrive soon allowing them to embark for "the good old U.S.A." Hearing that Bendola and his sister are planning a reception upon his homecoming, he announces his intention to "eat and sleep for a month." He also takes pleasure in recent gifts of chocolates and his purchase of eggs.
