ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Danville branch of the American Association of University Women was organized at a meeting held on 16 February 1923 in Danville, Kentucky. Besides discussing and acting on matters related to women faculty and employees at Centre College, the organization raised scholarship funds for women to attend institutions of higher education. The group also sponsored programming for members and supported educational activities such as the purchase of books for local libraries, public programming, seminars for students interested in attending college, and supporting the Girl Scouts. The branch also spoke out on local and national social issues, such as the purification of milk in the Danville area, the preservation of the city's historic post office, and the role of women in society. The Danville chapter was always supportive of state and national AAUW initiatives and sponsored the state convention on several occasions. The Danville chapter became part of Bluegrass Central Branch in 2003.

COLLECTION NOTE

Box 1, Folder 2 includes the constitution and by-laws for the Danville branch. Folder 3 houses historical material related to the Danville branch; annual updates are included from 1959 to 1968. Folders 4 through 9 house the minutes of the Danville chapter from 1923 to 1995, although there is a considerable gap from 1953 to 1973. Reports from the branch president from 1932 to 1985 are included in Folder 10; reports are not available for every year. Folder 11 features limited financial information about the branch. Folder 12 houses correspondence for the Danville branch, and Folder 13 includes membership information from 1949 to 1993. Information related to programming sponsored by the Danville branch can be found in Folder 14. Information about scholarships, always an important initiative of the branch, can be located in Folder 15. Issues of the Danville branch's newsletter are found in Folder 16. Folder 17 is a catch-all folder for miscellaneous items including an AAUW patch, news clippings, stationery, etc.

Box 2, Folder 1 contains a variety of items featuring information about the Kentucky division of AAUW including board minutes, membership directories, historical information, flyers for programming, bylaws, etc. Folder 2 contains information about conventions held by the Kentucky

division and Folders 3 and 4 include newsletters of the same. Folder 5 includes information about the South East Central region of the AAUW and several photographs featuring Judy Adams who served as president of the same. Folder 6 houses the constitution and by-laws of the national AAUW adopted in 1921.
