COLLECTION NOTE

This collection contains research material gathered for presentations by Bowling Green, Kentucky attorney, Ray B. Buckberry, Jr. The two topics covered are: the history and development of grocery stores; and Operation Tiger, the practice battle for D-Day which took place at Slapton Sands, Devon, England on 28 April 1944. The grocery store material concentrates on the history of these institutions, food deserts of the twenty-first century, and the operation of neighborhood grocery stores in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Buckberry's online research material about grocery stores is in electronic format and can be accessed by clicking on the hyperlink below for Folder 6. Scripts for the presentations on grocery stores are included in Folder 2; other research information more specific to Bowling Green, Kentucky grocery stores can be found in Folders 3-6. Photographs of Bowling Green, Kentucky and Warren County, Kentucky neighborhood groceries taken by Buckberry were given to the Kentucky Library Research Collections.

Information gathered by Buckberry about Operation Tiger starts in Folder 7 with scripts of presentations. Photographs related to Operation Tiger can be found in Folder 8. Facsimilies of documents related to Operation Tiger are included in Folder 9. Folder 10 holds research material collected related to LSTs or Landing Ship Tanks. A printed report titled "The American Assault Exercises at Slapton Sands, Devon, in 1944" is located in Folder 11. A few news clippings about the Operation from the 1980s are included in Folder 12. Folder 13 includes information about Dero Goodman Downing's participation in Operation Tiger and his annual remembrance of the day with a commemorative flag. Downing later became president of Western Kentucky University. Buckberry's online research related to Operation Tiger can be accessed by clicking the two hyperlinks below for Folder 14. Folder 15 contains a reel of microfilm titled "Tiger Exercise: E Boat Attack in the English Channel, 28 April 1944."
