Letters to Captain Lee Owsley Haskins, written by his family in Bowling Green, Kentucky during his World War I military service. His father describes his business activities, discusses his son's plans after the war, and reports in November 1918 of the ebbing of the influenza epidemic and the Board of Health's plan to "lift the Ban." His mother refers to his recent surgery, and his sister writes of the arrival of a troop train in Bowling Green and the soldiers' march downtown for canteen service.
