ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Kentucky Colonel chapter of the American Business Women's Association (ABWA) was started on 3 June 1964 by Jean Fulkerson in Bowling Green, Kentucky. Twenty-six women met at Western Hills Restaurant and elected Linda Sidebottom as the first president. By September, the chapter had completed a year of requirements and received the Standard of Achievement and Banner Chapter awards at the organization's 1964 national convention. For many years, the chapter received these honors, and in 1972 the chapter received "Star" status, a distinction shared with only seventeen chapters in the United States. The Kentucky Colonel chapter sponsored the Hilltopper 76 chapter in Bowling Green in 1976. The Bowling Green Charter chapter (1960), and the Cardinals of Kentucky chapter (1982) were also located in Bowling Green.

Besides providing professional development opportunities, one of the long-time projects of the Kentucky Colonel chapter has been a scholarship program recognizing women who were furthering their education. To facilitate the scholarship fund and to raise money for the organization's administrative needs, the ladies have held fundraisers such as golf tournaments, cat shows, children's beauty pageants, fashion shows, and sold a variety of items including pecan/nuts. For many years the organization held a "Boss Night," where a "Boss of the Year" and a "Woman of the Year" was announced. At various times, the organization also held a "Business Associate Banquet."

The Kentucky Colonel chapter ended sometime in the 2010s.

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists of the records of the Kentucky Colonel chapter of the ABWA. None of the records are complete. Folder 2 contains a brief handwritten history of the organization. Folder 3 includes minutes of the Kentucky Colonel chapter, and Folder 4 includes agendas for some of those meetings. Folder 5 includes monthly financial statements. Folder 6 and 7 hold guidebooks from ABWA: policy and procedure manuals in Folder 5 and committee guides in Folder 6. Folder 6 also includes a few committee rosters from the Kentucky Colonel

chapter. Folder 8 houses news clippings about the chapter, and folder 9 includes yearbooks for the same. Folders 10 and 11 includes a continuous scrapbook that documents the chapter's activities. Folders 12 holds programs from various events sponsored by the chapter, and Folder 13 includes programs from the chapter's annual "Boss Night." Folder 14 includes a few intact copies of the chapter's newsletter The Colonelette; 219 issues of the chapter's newsletter were scanned and archived in TopSCHOLAR. The intact copies have not been included in the count of items for this collection; they were kept chiefly for exhibit purposes. Folder 15 includes miscellaneous material related to the chapter, including two of the ABWA's national newsletters, certificates, invitations, a 1997 chapter survey and corollary member questionnaire, a membership list from 1999, and a skit used for a chapter program.
