**COLLECTION NOTE**

The Barren River Imaginative Museum of Science (BRIMS) was founded in 1994 to “engage the community in discoveries about science, scientists, and the process and outcomes of scientific exploration by presenting scientific and mathematical principles in an interactive way.” It occupied an A-frame building at 1229 Center Street, near Western Kentucky University. The Museum housed science-related exhibits and hosted programming that supported its educational mission. The Museum was open to the public, but was particularly marketed to school groups. It also partnered with WKU and the Green River Regional Educational Cooperative to provide training for teachers. For a number of years Chuck Phillips served as the Museum’s Executive Director. When he retired in 2011, the Board could not afford to hire a new director and make needed repairs to the facility. Briefly in 2012, the Museum had an exhibit area at the Greenwood Mall, but that arrangement did not last.

This collection includes some administrative papers: by-laws (Folder 2), minutes of the Board of Directors meetings (Folder 3), correspondence (Folder 4), and newsletters (Folder 7) The remaining folders in the collection contain information and photographs related to events and programming sponsored by the Museum. The digital photographs have been saved in the WKU Photo Archives.
