#### ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Bowling Green Rose Society was organized on 28 November 1960. At a meeting on 9 January 1961, Hayward Brown was elected its first president. The Society received charter membership in the American Rose Society on 1 January 1961. Its first show was held at the First Christian Church on 30 September 1961, and it has customarily held annual shows since then. In addition, it holds in-club competitions and members participate in American Rose Society Shows. The Society holds monthly meetings, issues a monthy newsletter, *Rosebuds*, and sponsors the Bowling Green Rose Society Graduate English Scholarship at WKU.

### **COLLECTION NOTE**

This collection consists of a small amount of records of the Bowling Green Rose Society. The bulk of the material dates from the 1980s and 1990s. Included are minutes (Folder 3); correspondence about shows, tours, memorial donations and advice on growing roses (Folder 4); show programs and results (Folders 8 and 9); and materials relating to the Society's charter membership in the American Rose Society (Folder 12). Other material includes collected songs and skits developed for entertainment at meetings and other events (Folder 10). Business records include the Society's American Rose Society Charter and bylaws (Folder 2); applications for tax exemptions (Folder 7); insurance records (Folder 11); and a financial statement from 1998 (Folder 13). A few clippings (Folder 6) highlight members' gardening skills, and a newsletter from 2010 (Folder 5) contains a historical review of the Society's first 50 years.
