ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The McClure Brothers store was operated in the early 20th century by brothers Joseph Schuyler McClure (1871-1939) and Jonathan “John” L. McClure (1868-1943). The last owner was John’s son Paul McClure (1911-1991). In 1976, Paul sold the property; the following year the store building was razed and the land converted into a parking lot for the nearby Methodist Church.

COLLECTION NOTE

This collection contains records of the McClure Brothers store in Millerstown, Kentucky. The bulk of the collection (Folders 3-9) consists of a representative sample of invoices rendered to the store for purchases from manufacturers, wholesalers and distributors of goods such as groceries, hardware, clothing, books, medicines and toiletries, farming implements, animal feed, candy, shoes, tobacco, china and glassware, hats, home furnishings, housewares, saddles and harnesses, and seeds. Many suppliers were located in Louisville, but some were elsewhere in Kentucky and nearby states. The bulk of the invoices date from 1903-1920, and many display the elaborate type and engravings common to the period. In a few cases, additional promotional material from the suppliers is included. Other store records in the collection are: store letterhead and a sampling of cancelled checks (Folder 2); a catalog from the Wm. Wrigley Company offering goods in conjunction with orders of chewing gum (Folder 12); World War II-era literature to merchants from the Office of Price Administration (Folder 13); numerous red and blue OPS tokens used in connection with rationing, and a collection box for redeeming the tokens at a bank (Folder 14); an accounts ledger (Folder 15); and store licences (Folder 16). Miscellaneous items consist of correspondence regarding a soldier’s pension claim by Schuyler McClure (Folder 10); a lease of property in Grayson County (Folder 11); and account memos and notes from customers (Folder 16). Also included (Folder 16) is a page clipped from a magazine and probably used for signage that states “Blame Hitler for Shortages.”
