### **COLLECTION NOTE**

Peridot Pictures, owned by Dorian and Elaine Walker, moved to Bowling Green from Los Angeles in 1993. In 1997, in connection with the celebration of the Bowling Green-Warren County (Kentucky) bicentennial and in partnership with the Landmark Association of Bowling Green, the company produced a film exploring the history of the city and county. Featuring interviews, archival material from WKU's Department of Library Special Collections, and dramatizations using local talent, the one-hour film premiered in March 1998 at the Capitol Arts Theatre in Bowling Green. Videocassettes of the film were also made available.

This collection consists of materials created during the planning and production of the film: a proposal to the Bowling-Green Warren County Bicentennial Commission; sponsorship appeals; correspondence; publicity materials; personnel lists; script materials; and interviews with local historians and other citizens, who provided background and sometimes personal memories about various aspects of the area's history.
