COLLECTION NOTE

This collection consists of the minutes of the Kentucky Speech Arts Association from 1931-1962. Additional material such as correspondence, membership lists, program notices, and financial data is sometimes appended to the minutes (a cumulative membership list from 1936-1953 appears at the end of Folder 4).

The organization was conceived in November 1931, when representatives of several colleges across Kentucky met to discuss forming a state organization for speech teachers. The original resolution was to organize as “The Kentucky Association of Teachers of Speech,” with Pearl Buchanan of Eastern State Teachers College as the first president. The next minutes, dated 29 April 1932, however, refer to the organization as “The Kentucky Speech Arts Association.” At a meeting on 31 October 1936, a motion was adopted to change the name “to the one originally used – Kentucky Teachers of Speech,” but subsequent minutes and letterhead refer variously to the Kentucky Association of Teachers of Speech, the Kentucky Speech Arts Association, and the Kentucky Speech Association.
