State Board

This agreement made and entered into this September 20th, 1910, between the Western Kentucky State Normal School, party of the first part, and the State Board of Health of Kentucky, party of the second part.

Witnesseth! That for and in consideration of their mutual interest in the promotion of education and health, and of other considerations hereinafter named, the party of the first part agrees to furnish to the party of the second part for the term of four years, from January 1, 1911, the third story of the right rear wing of the Potter College Building, formerly occupied as a gymnasium and music and art rooms, partitioned into rooms as desired, by the party of the second part and ^{also} an office and ^{all of which is to be} laboratory room in the front right wing, ^{for} equipped with heat, gas, electric light, water and with janitor service furnished, and to have its faculty give a course of practical instruction as to the prevention of disease to its classes, and, in so far as practicable, to such county institutes as are conducted by members of said faculty. For such courses of instruction and the use of such offices, rooms and space herein before mentioned, the party of the second part agrees to have the heads of its scientific departments give such instruction to the classes of the party of the first part and to those of the Eastern Kentucky Normal School, as pertain to their respective departments, at such times and ways as may be agreed upon, and to give to the faculty and scientific and other students of the said Western Kentucky Normal School the benefit of its laboratories and laboratory instruction in so far as can be done without interference with the official work of the said party of the second part. The party of the second part further agrees to pay for the heat, gas, electric light, water and janitor service in such proportion as ^{is used as shown by meter measure} the cubic feet of the rooms and halls occupied by it bear to the rooms and halls of the entire building.
