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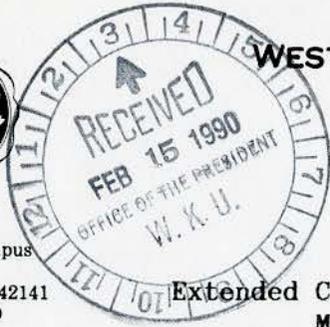

- I. Dr. Heck opened the meeting by summarizing the committees progress. He also distributed an Extended Campus Spring Enrollment report and Extended Campus Faculty Statistics report.
- II. Dr. Uveges reviewed the results of the faculty survey. 101 responses were received out of 162 sent out for a 62.3% response rate. Dr. Uveges suggested items for cross tabulation. He then reviewed the 62 items. Much discussion followed. Further analysis of narrative and objective items will follow. Dr. Uveges, Dr. Heck, Dr. Hoover, Dr. Koper will meet on February 8 to evaluate written responses.
- III. Dr. Schnacke reviewed the progress of the curriculum survey. Dr. Ray said that he had survey responses for his college. Dr. Hoover said that surveys had been distributed to all Department Heads in her college.
- IV. Dr. Ray, Dr. Strickler, Dr. Hazzard, and Dr. Schnacke gave brief updates on their sub-committee's progress.
- V. Dr. Schnacke suggested that our study be made available to "Western 21." Discussion regarding "Western 21" followed.

- I. Dr. Heck began the meeting by inviting the committee to a reception on the Glasgow Campus scheduled for March 1, 1990. He reminded the committee that sub-committee reports were due in to him on March 20. He also reviewed the format.
- II. Dr. Schnacke offered an update on the curriculum survey. He noted how helpful John Foe was in accumulating data and requested that a special note of thanks be sent to Mr. Foe. Dr. Schnacke noted that, in general, the Deans perceptions of extended campus operations were in line with faculty. He noted, however, that the Deans perceptions of faculty satisfaction with tentative extended campus courses seemed to be lower than what the faculty actually reported in the faculty survey. Much discussion followed.
- III. Dr. Uveges reported on the faculty survey. He presented a seven page narrative summarizing the faculty survey. Dr. Heck thanked him for his long hours of hard work on the faculty survey.
- IV. Dr. Counts outlined his recommendations concerning instructional equipment and media support. He suggested the other centers be brought up to the level of media support present at Owensboro.
- V. Dr. Koper presented a summary of the subjective responses on the faculty survey. Discussion followed.
- VI. Dr. Ray summarized areas of the faculty survey that dealt with travel.
- VII. Dr. Heck adjourned the meeting at 10:00 a.m. and reminded members of the next meeting focusing upon recommendations scheduled for February 27.
