At a called meeting of the Trustees of Ogden College, held at the office of Max B. Nehm, in Bowling Green, Ky., on January 4th 1940, there were present, President Max B. Nehm, John B. Rodes, E.B. Stout and Cooper R. Smith.

The death of R.C.P. Thomas was announced as having occurred on November 11th 1939, and it appearing that Cooper R. Smith had been named and nominated as regent and trustee of Ogden College, and that said will of R.C.P. Thomas having been probated in the Warren County Court and that on the

the said Cooper R. Smith was appointed Regent and Trustee of Ogden College and of all the properties and funds devoted to said college and to the cause of education under the terms of said will of Robert W. Ogden, the said Board of Trustees of Ogden College hereby and herein approved of the appointment of said Cooper R. Smith as regent and trustee of Ogden College.

It appearing that a vacancy existed in the office of Secretary of the Board of Trustees of Ogden College, Max B. Nehm made motion and duly seconded that Cooper R. Smith be nominated to fill the vacancy, motion carried.

Matter of Leichhardt Bros., C.D.S. #6, to construct six rooms on second floor of building at 448 Main St., was discussed. Upon motion of John B. Rodes and duly seconded it was decided that Leichhardt Bros., be advised that 10% of cost of improvements be added to rent and any increase in insurance premiums be paid by said Leichhardt Bros., Motion carried.

Matters of investment were discussed. There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
