At a called meeting of the Board of Trustees of Ogden College at the office of John B Rodes on Tuesday Sept. 19th 1944, there were present President Max B Nahm, John B Rodes, Ward Sumpter and Cooper R Smith.

It was moved by Mr Rodes and seconded by Mr Sumpter that the twenty two applications be approved. Motion carries. Due to the fact that for the school years of 1942-43 and 1943-44 Ogden College had used \$2,388.25 of its \$2,500.00 ^{2700.00} in scholarships, there being a balance of \$111.25 and estimating that all of these 22 scholarships for the year 1944-45 would not be entirely used up it was thought that 22 scholarships could be granted without exceeding the yearly allotment of \$1250.00 in scholarships.

The secretary reported that a new rental contract had been entered into with Nettersworth Motor Co. at 1038 State St., and facing on 11th st, for the rental of this building for a five year period beginning with Jan 1st 1945 and terminating Dec 31st 1949, rental at \$150 ^{per month} for the first year (1945) and rental for the balance four years at \$200 per month. this action was approved by the Board.

The matter of the rental contracts of Galloway Motor Co and Jones Motor Co. was duscysed and it was decided that the Secretary see these parties with a view of getting the rent of these two pieces of property at 1010 and 1018 State St respectively restored to the former price in effect before the rationing of the sales of automobiles, brought on by the World War II.

The matter of Tom Holman desiring to purchase frontage on Cenetary Road of Ogden Farm Property it was the opinion of the Board that a survey be made of this property before taking any action.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
