My dear Mrs. Bradner:

Word has just come to me that you have telephoned to inquire about the reported illness of your son Raymond. In the absence of President Cherry I am writing you to tell you you have absolutely no cause for uneasiness as he is not even sick enough to be confined to his bed. The management of the school has asked that he remain in one of the comfortable buildings owned by the school here on the edge of the campus for the usual period of quarantine in case of smallpox. The physician has asked this and in fact, requires it in order to safeguard the boy as well as other individuals who have been rooming in the house with him. He will be given excellent care and you may rest assured that it will be only a matter of a short time until he is able to resume his class work. I am sure you understand that every precaution of this kind must be taken both for the sake of the boy and the school. We shall be glad to have you keep in touch with us and if you desire to do so you may call every day, or every two days so that you may be informed if any change occurs. The boy is hardly sick at all, but it will be necessary for him to be in quarantine for a number of days. As possibly you know, Superintendent Shaw is in the same building with him. Their meals are being sent them three times a day from our regular dining room.

It is a pleasure to give you any information I can.
