

## Muhlenberg County, Kentucky and Related Obituaries, 1888 - 2020.

The obituaries, death notices, funeral home cards, etc. have been collected from Muhlenberg County and surrounding county newspapers and funeral home material. Most of the collection was completed by Brenda Collier Doss prior to 1995. Later material and some earlier material has been added by Gail Jackson Miller. The original collection was composed of clippings from newspapers available to Mrs. Doss and Mrs. Miller. These were added to notebooks arranged by surname letter. The clippings were in no particular order. The current collection has been arranged alphabetically by Mrs. Miller within each surname grouping. Most of the clippings were originally labeled with an abbreviation for the newspaper and the publication date. Later, many of clippings were labeled with the name of the newspaper and location plus the publication date. The collection contains a large number of obituaries but should not be considered to be complete. It should be useful to individuals with Muhlenberg County, Kentucky connections since many of the county newspapers do not have complete archival collections and many early newspapers have not been filmed or digitized.

Most of the obituaries were obtained from the Greenville and Central City, Kentucky newspapers. However, the collection also includes some obituaries from newspapers from the surrounding area. The following list contains most of the newspapers involved. Abbreviations used when the clippings were originally done have been added in parentheses.

Central City, Kentucky: *The Argus*, *The Messenger*, and *Times Argus* [TA].

Greenville, Kentucky: *The Echo*, *The Greenville Leader*, *Leader-News* [LN], and *The Record*.

Beaver Dam, Kentucky: *The Messenger*.

Bowling Green, Kentucky: *The Daily-News*. [DN]

Hartford, Kentucky: *Times-News*.

Hopkinsville, Kentucky: *The New Era*. [NE]

Louisville, Kentucky: *The Courier Journal*. [CJ]

Madisonville, Kentucky: *The Messenger*.

Morgantown, Kentucky: *The Green River Republican*.

Owensboro, Kentucky: *Messenger-Inquirer*. [MI]

Russellville, Kentucky: *The Logan Leader* [LL] and *The News Democrat* [ND].
