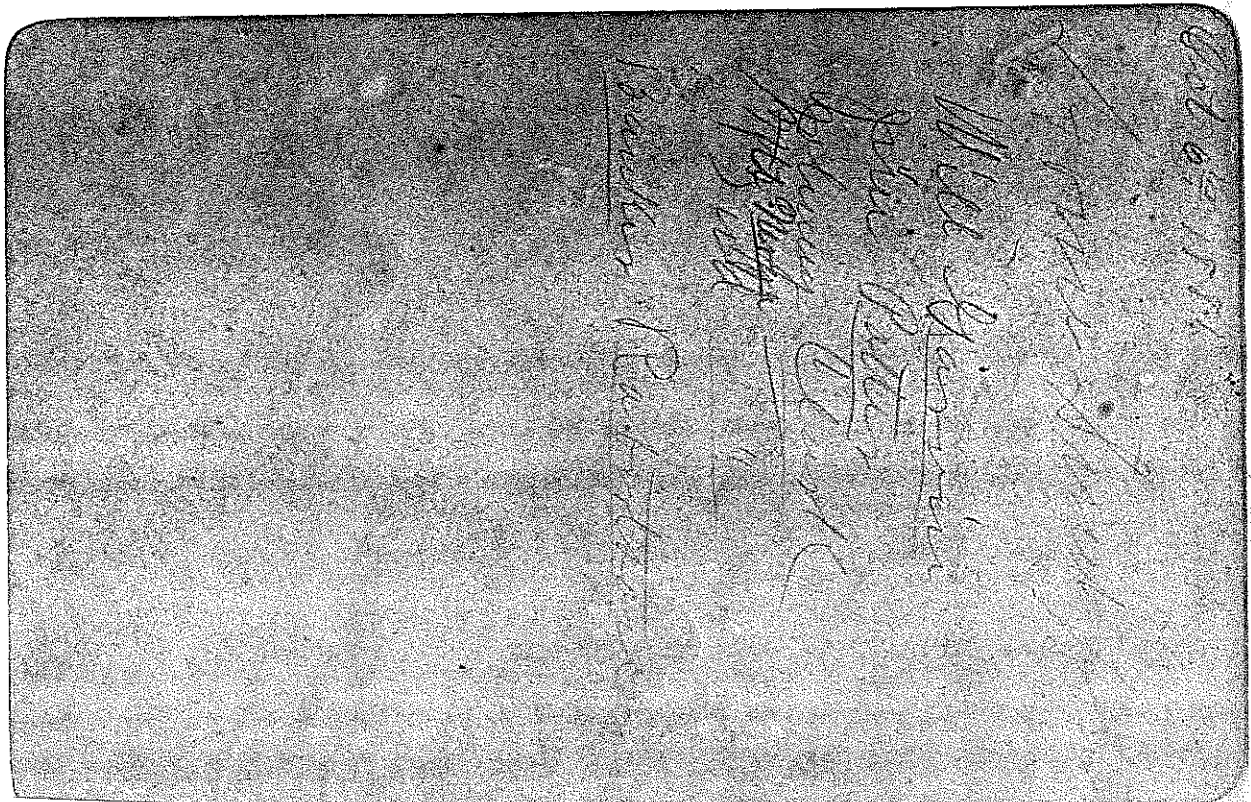

# AGED WOMAN DIES AS RESULT OF FALL ON LAST MONDAY

Mrs. Charles A. Gossom, Aged  
82, of Smith's Grove, Had  
Lived in Warren County all  
of Her Life

HAD BEEN MARRIED  
OVER SIXTY YEARS

Deceased Was member of Old  
Family and Was Born With-  
in Short Distance of Bow-  
ling Green

Mrs. Charles A. Gossom, aged  
Smith's Grove woman, who had her  
hip fractured by a fall last Monday  
afternoon, died this morning at 1:30  
o'clock as a result of her injury. At  
the time of the accident physicians  
said that on account of her advanced  
age Mrs. Gossom would probably die.  
She rallied a couple of days ago, but  
yesterday became very weak and  
suffered great deal until death came  
to her relief.

Mrs. Gossom was 82 years of age  
and spent a lot of her life in this coun-  
ty. She was born in the Oakland  
vicinity, her maiden name being  
Mary Mitchell, a daughter of Mr. and  
Mrs. Henry Mitchell, pioneer settlers  
of Warren county. Mr. and Mrs. Gos-  
son were married over sixty years  
ago.

Mrs. Gossom is survived by her hus-  
band, four daughters, Mrs. George  
Lewison and Miss Anna Gossom of  
Smith's Grove, Mrs. Kattie Jones, of  
Bowling Green, Mrs. Wyatt Jones, of  
Texas, five grand-children and one  
great-grand-child. Her husband is  
a retired farmer.

The funeral will be held tomorrow  
morning at 10 o'clock from the fam-  
ily residence. Service are to be con-  
ducted by the Rev. Atkins, of Smith's  
Grove Baptist church, of which the  
deceased was a member, and the in-  
terment is to be made in the Old  
Fellows cemetery.
