Green County Ky Aug. 22^d 1826

By the help and influence of an agent in the Bible cause there was organized on the 10th day, Inst. at Bethel Church in this County, a Bible Society Auxiliary to the A. B. S. the first Article of ^{the Constitution of} this public Auxiliary is in the following words to wit - "This Society shall be called the Green County Bible Society, Auxiliary to the American Bible Society, whose sole object shall be, to circulate the word of God & without note or comment" and shall after supplying its own wants, transmit its surplus funds annually to the parent Society" We number about 120 members, Amount of Subscriptions, about \$120.00

As the corresponding secretary, I make this communication through you to the parent Society, hoping we may be acknowledged as an Auxiliary, and ^{if so} that you will be so good as to inform us whether at any, or at what time, we may by application accompanied by sufficient funds obtain a supply of the Holy Scriptures from your Depository to supply our own wants, which we anticipate will be very great in proportion to our population - And (if not too burdensome) inform what the different qualities of Bibles and new Testaments ^{will cost} - ^{that} whether ^{they} can be properly packed in boxes and forwarded to Louisville Ky. - And indeed of every thing you may think necessary to be known by an infant institution having almost every thing to learn -
