as Mt Zabor to worship in a new  
church situated on the waters of Middle fork  
of Trakes creek in Warren County State  
of Ky in the bounds of the Logan  
presbytery the members mostly from  
Union congregation Warren County Ky  
entered into the following agreement  
we the undersigned do agree to unite  
ourselves in to a body Ecclesiastic under  
the name of Mt Zabor congregation of  
the Cumberland Presbyterian Church and  
do promise to walk in all the commands  
ments and ordinances of Gods house  
blameless looking to the above named  
Church for the institution of the means  
of grace

N B Those who now hold their membership  
at an other place will be considered  
members here when they shall  
have secured letters of dismission from  
their respected societies

The founding members from Union  
Congregation caused their names to be  
affixed

Isaac H. Goodnight, Margaret E. J. Goodnight and Lucretia Clay Mason were received having been baptised in infancy.

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Mt. Tabor Church was founded in 1861. Although the charter states the county as Warren, it is actually located in Simpson County. The church sat in the flat area at the bottom of the hill in front of the cemetery commonly referred to as Cold Water. The current name "Cold Water Cemetery" came from the "old"

Cold Water School that sat in the field behind the cemetery above Cold Water Spring. When the new school

was rebuilt, it was located on present day Hwy. 622 near the intersection with Harris Road.

The pages following the index represent the second of the Pastor's Journals that cover the period from 1875 through 1898. The pages are typed exactly as they appear in the book with a reference to any blank

pages. Misspelled words are typed as-is and noted. All names are spelled as they were written. The alphabetical index can be used to check names that are mentioned. Any clarifications that I could make are noted in ( ) some with a (?).

Any clarifications that you can make that would be of help to other researchers are welcome. If possible,

pass them along to me so I can include them in future reprints.
