May 1815 The church being organized proceeded to the order of electing brother Green Collier as deacon, who was chosen by a session at a previous meeting to fill the vacancy of brother Nathaniel Harington whose age and infirmities proved his purpose in that office which we gratefully acknowledge that he has faithfully performed in many years, the church and presbtery being satisfied of the qualification of Brother green collier, proceeded to ordain him by our worthy brethern, John Conley, pastor of this church, Edward Turner pasture of the Grace church, Richard Ray deacon of the same Benjamin Sherby deacon of the Grace Church and Thomas Earnest deacon of Qey Church.

Received Sister Nancy Jones by recantation and then appointed brother Richard Ray David Cutlip and Asle Davis commissioners to Engage eats for the convenience of this meeting house and pay the undertakers of the work out of the many suscribed for the purpose of repairing the meeting house, and in case of deficiency, the deficit to be supplied by the members of this church, Ordered that Brother Andrew Ray William Rowntree and John Rowntree fix and paint out the place and stand for convenience of the association, and the clerk prepare a letter as an address from this church to the next green River association and have it before the church at their next meeting for their inspection---
