I'll be hoping that you improve rapidly and that I get another message from you.

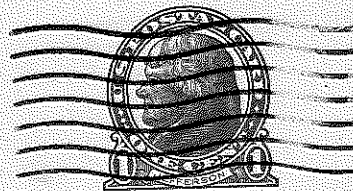
