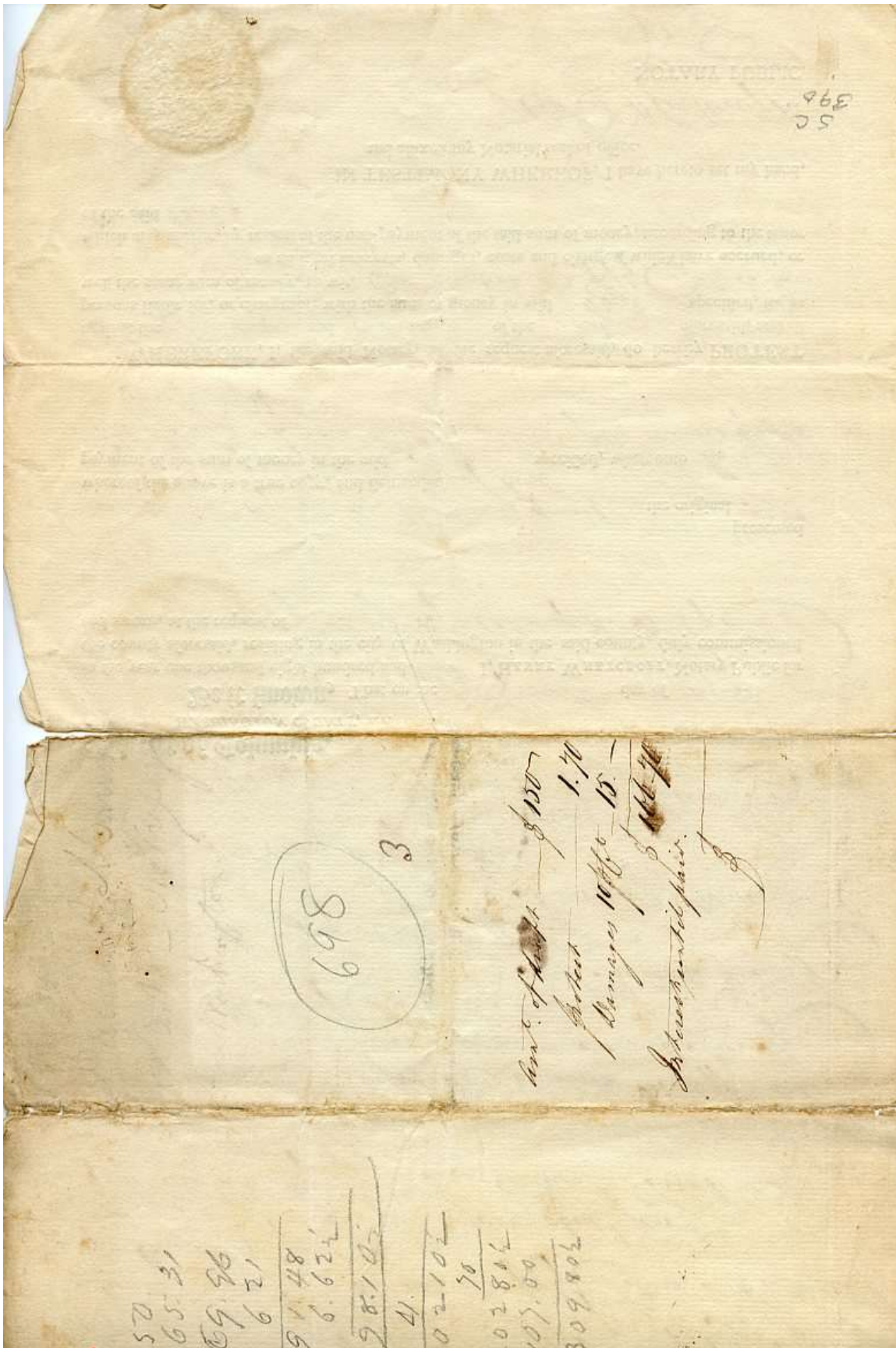
WASHINGTON COUNTY, *scv.*
