KNOW YE, That reposing especial trust and confidence in the integrity, diligence, and ability of *Samuel Conjunctin* I do appoint him

CLERK OF THE SUPREME COURT,

in the place of John A. Nelson who agrees to vacate his office in and for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, to preside in the *Third* Judicial District; thereby investing him with

full power and authority to execute and fulfil the duties of the said office, according to law: AND TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, with all the rights and emoluments thereunto legally appertaining, until the end of the next session of the General Assembly, if so long he shall behave well.

In Testimony Whereof, I have caused these letters to be made patent, and the Seal of the Commonwealth to be hereunto affixed. Done at FRANKFORT, the *28th* day of *September* - in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty *ninth* - and in the *26th* year of the Commonwealth.
