

Capt W Payne Set^d with the Government
The 21 of Aug. 1783 & drew a Ball of \$148⁰⁰ 20
On the 18th ap. 1785 he drew 4000 acres of
land for 3 years Service. If he served
on to 6 years his Bounty land would not
be increased. But after 6 years he would
be entitled to an addition at the rate of
1/6 for each additional year.

If an Officer at the end of the War
He is entitled if not Rec^d to half pay
for life, or 5 years full pay with 5 per
Cent interest until p^d depending on
the arrangement of the particular
Regiment to which he belonged at the
End of the War. In the waring
furnished the above Information
