

Contract Between Teachers and Trustees.

This article of agreement, entered
into on the ~~first~~^{second} day of July 1894
witnesseth:

That R. B. Calhoun has
contracted with John A. Walcott &
M. M. Jones

Trustees of white District number two
in the County of Boone, State of
Kentucky, at the said Common School
of said District for the term of five
months, beginning on
first day of October 1894, in accordance
with the common school laws and the
Rules and Regulations prescribed in
pursuance thereof by the State Board
of Education for the compensation of
the public funds allotted to said
District.

The said Trustee hereby holds
himself subject to the legal super-
vision and direction of said Trustees,
and to the visitation and lawful au-
thority of the county superintendent,
the said Trustee reserving the right
of dismissing said Teacher at any
time without, for any of the causes
specified in the Kentucky School Law.
It is further agreed that the said
Trustee releases and waives all the claims

price, beauty, a good supply of good
fence, fresh water, lighted roads,
canyons, rivers or built and all the
necessary shore furniture and other
native things.
