

CONTRACT BETWEEN TEACHER AND TRUSTEES.

This Article of Agreement entered into on the 26 day of June, 1929 witnesseth:
 That Fannie Hanks holding a first class certificate, has contracted with the 4th
Educational Div. board, and
 Trustees of District No. _____ in the County of Powell, State of Kentucky, to teach
 the Common School of said District for the term of 6 months, beginning on Monday the
5 day of July, 1929, in accordance with the Common School Laws and the Rules
 and Regulations prescribed in pursuance thereof by the State Board of Education, for the sum of Public
money due said dist. for said school year 1929,
 Said District has a census enrollment of 47 pupil children.

The said teacher hereby holds himself subject to the legal supervision and direction of said Trustees, and to the visita-
 tion and lawful authority of the County Superintendent, the said Trustees reserving the right to dismiss said teacher at any
 time whatever, for any of the causes specified in the Common School Laws.

It is also agreed that the fire shall be regularly made and the floor regularly swept in said house, during said term, by
 the said* Teacher the said Trustees providing the fuel and brooms therefor.
