there is granted by the said Commonwealth, unto

a certain TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, containing *One Hundred Eighty* Acres, by survey,
bearing date the *4th* day of *November* one thousand *Seven* hundred and *ninety three*
lying and being in the *County of Nelson on the South of the Beech fork and bounded as follows To wit*
Beginning at a large poplar & back on the bank of the beech fork on Bensons line N 75° E 140 poles
to two sugar trees in a hollow S 43° W 26 poles to a hickory Spanish Oak Creek, N 75° E 34 poles to a white
oak and elm James Dennis corner S 40° E 100 poles to an elm & walnut N 75° E 34 poles to a white oak and
red oak N 70° E 156 poles to three sugar trees on Dennis line S 80° E 6 poles to two elms on the beech fork thence up the
same binding thence to the Beginning

With its appurtenances: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAID TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, with its appurtenances, to the said *James*

Macon

and *his* heirs forever.
