*Number one hundred and twenty four the eighth day of May one thousand seven hundred and eighty three*

there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto *William Reynolds Agent of Cary Thwait*

a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing *One thousand Acres, by survey bearing date the third day of January*  
*one thousand seven hundred and eighty five. Lying and being in the District set apart for the Officers & Soldiers of*  
*the State line on the North side of Big Barrens River and bounded as follows the County Beginning on the*  
*River at the upper corner of William Thompsons Survey. N. 26. E. at three Poles, extending thence up the River with*  
*the several Courses thereof South thirty degrees East three hundred poles crossing a Branch, South sixty three degrees*  
*East one hundred and sixteen poles crossing a Branch to a Locust tree, Beech and Sugar tree standing on the bank of said*  
*River North sixty degrees East four hundred poles to two Chestnuts and Poplar North thirty nine degrees West four hundred*  
*poles to two white oaks and Black gum South thirty nine degrees West four hundred poles passing William Thompsons Survey*  
*and crossing a Branch to the Beginning*

with its Appurtenances; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land with its Appurtenances, to  
the said *William Reynolds* and his Heirs for ever.
