

Esquire, Governor of the Commonwealth of VIRGINIA,

TO ALL TO WHOM these Presents shall come, GREETING: KNOW YE, that

*Military Warrant Number five hundred eleven, Two thousand eight hundred fourteen, Two thousand eight hundred fifteen, Two thousand eight hundred sixteen and Three thousand nine hundred and twenty eight*

there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto

*Robert Craddock*

a certain Tract or Parcel of Land, containing

*Five hundred and Ninety Acres by Survey bearing due the South side of a line one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, lying and being in the District set apart for the Office and Locating of the Western State line, and bounded as followeth To wit, Beginning on the Bank of Little Barren River about five hundred and thirty Poles on a straight line above the mouth of the East fork of said River at two Elm and Lycamore, running thence South Seventy degrees West Seventy eight Poles to three white oaks, thence West one hundred and sixteen Poles to two white oaks, thence South thirty degrees West one hundred and ten Poles to a maple and two beeches on the bank of the River, thence up the River with its meanders South forty degrees West Twenty four Poles, South five degrees West Twenty Poles, South thirty five degrees East Twenty Poles, South Sixty five degrees East Thirty two Poles, E 20 Poles, S 50 E 120 Poles leaving the River at 30 Poles to an ash and two white oaks on the Bank of the River, thence down the River with its meanders N 35 E 32 Poles, N 34 Poles to a black oak and two black gums, thence crossing the River N 45 E 126 Poles to an Elm and two black oaks, thence N 28 W 115 Poles to the South East corner of John Lecky Survey two white oaks and Spanish oaks, thence West with his line 30 Poles to a corner two black oaks and two cedars in said Survey, thence down the River with its meanders N 72 W 20 Poles, W 20 Poles, S 75 W 36 Poles, S 55 W 34 Poles, South Seventy five degrees West fifty two Poles to the Beginning*

with its Appurtenances; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract or Parcel of Land with its Appurtenances, to the said *Robert Craddock* and his Heirs for ever.
